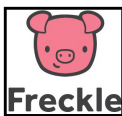
Archdiocese of Detroit

2020-2021 School Year

The application to apply for the Archdiocesan Tuition Assistance Grant for grades K-8th is now open and **MUST be submitted by April 30, 2020. Applications can only be completed online.** Please go to <https://online.factsmgt.com> or to the Archdiocesan website link <https://www.detroitcatholicschools.org/tuition-assistance-scholarships>.

You must download, fill out, print, and turn in the Pastor Signature Sheet to your parish for signature. You must be an active parishioner in a parish within the Archdiocese of Detroit. Once it is signed, it must be turned in to the school office so we can finish the process.
